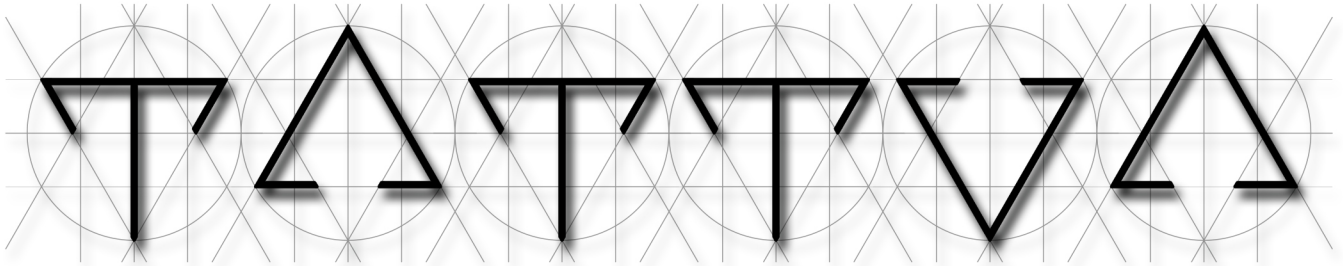

Some of the best student works from across the different subjects were exhibited. It was truly a treat for the eyes to witness some really great works. Kudos guys!

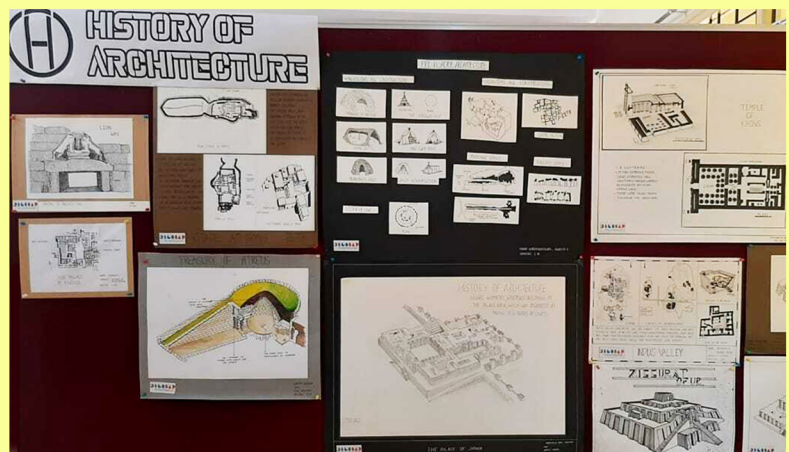
